## Neatly and graphically represent situation(s)

Carefully read the problem three times.  
 Draw object(s) and relevant aspects of environment.  
 Identify requested unknowns.

## Graphically represent quantities and their relationships

### Free-body diagram

- B** – Use dashed bubble to indicate object(s) in system.
- E** – Is the **E**arth nearby (right now)?
- T** – Is anything **t**ouching the system (right now)?
- A** – Draw **a**xes (indicate  $+x$  and  $+y$  directions), with a positive direction matching direction of system's acceleration. If there is no direction of acceleration, orient axes to minimize the number of forces that fail to point along a drawn axis.

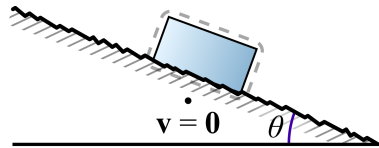
## Communicate

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**Example:** Complete a force component chart for a block resting on a rough plane inclined at an angle of  $\theta$  above the horizontal.

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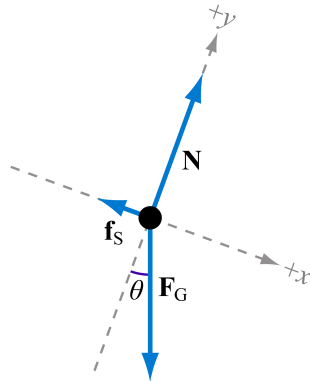


?: Force component chart
